In making entries in columns 9, 10, 11, 15, 16 to 23, an affirmative mark only will be used—thus /—except in the case of colored persons, column 11, when the letter "D" is to be used.
Question No. 10 will only be asked in cases where an affirmative answer has been given either to question 10 or to question 11.
Question No. 14 will only be asked in cases where a gainful occupation has been reported in column 13.
In column 7 an abbreviation in the name of the month may be used, as Jan., Apr., Dec.
