Lucewell and Cynthia Ann, A. Sally Ann, and Mary  
W Crump children of the party of the first part  
of the second part, and Rutherford R Rowntree  
of the third part, the parties of the 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> part  
of Edmondson County & State of Kentucky and  
the said Rowntree of Marion County & State  
aforesaid - Witnesses, that the said party of  
the first part part for an inconsideration of  
the natural love and affection they bear their  
said children (having already provided for their  
elder children) and for the further consideration  
of the sum of three Dollars to them in hand  
paid, the receipt of which they do hereby acknow-  
ledge granted bargain and sold and by these  
premises do sell give and convey unto the said  
R R Rowntree in trust for the said party of the  
2<sup>nd</sup> part two certain tracts or parcels of land  
situated lying and being in the County of Edmondson  
and the south of Green River the first contain  
124 acres being the land heretofore conveyed to  
the said J W Crump by R S Gardner off  
of which said Crump has since sold & conveyed  
to F W Jones five acres, The other tract contain  
600 acres the residue of 1000 acres after conveying  
to R S Gardner 400 Acres thereof, said 1000 acres  
was patented to R S Gardner conveyed by him  
to Geo. Patrick & by A Plocally in fact for

Pickett to said crump. The conveyances to be made  
 one of record in the clerks office of Camouson  
 County, to which for greater certainty reference  
 is had, with their appurtenances. Also one Negro  
 woman named Hannah, aged 35 years, one boy  
 named James Lewis, aged about nine years, one  
 other boy named Daniel Sampson, aged about  
 six years. Last Mich, and one girl named Martha  
 Eliza aged one year. To have and to hold the  
 said land and slaves to the party of the 3<sup>rd</sup> in  
 trust for the party of the 2<sup>nd</sup> part, and to their  
 heirs forever, and the said crump & wife covenant  
 and agrees to and with the said party of 3<sup>rd</sup>  
 part that they will warrant and defend the  
 said land and slaves from themselves and their  
 heirs and from the right title interest claim  
 and demand of all and every person or persons  
 whatever to the said party of the 3<sup>rd</sup> part in  
 trust as appreser & their heirs forever  
 It is further understood and the power and  
 authority is hereby conferred upon the said trustee  
 to bargain sell and convey by deed with General  
 warrant and by Bill of sale & warrants for  
 such price or prices as he may consider just  
 and reasonable, when he may think the interest  
 of the party of the 2<sup>nd</sup> part shall require it, either  
 or both the tracts of land or either or all the  
 slaves and their increase hereby conveyed, and  
 to best the proceeds in stock or other lands &  
 slaves as he may consider most conducive to the  
 interests of said party of the 2<sup>nd</sup> part or the sur-  
 vivors of said party, making such disposition of said  
 property or its proceeds as in his estimation  
 will most advance the interest of said party  
 It is further intended & determined and the  
 authority is hereby given to the party of the 3<sup>rd</sup>  
 part to appoint such person to succeed him  
 in his capacity as trustee as he may designate  
 and deem capable by and with the consent  
 and approbation of the party of the 1<sup>st</sup> part, alive  
 or if dead, of the party of the 2<sup>nd</sup> part, and the  
 said person so designated & appointed successor  
 shall have & possess all the authority in the  
 premises as the said Rowntree has & shall have  
 whereof the said party of the first part he

for Angelina B. Leump Isaac N. Leump Richard A. Leump  
Cynthia Ann A. Leump Sally Ann Leump and Mary W. Leump  
children of the said Deft<sup>r</sup> & Cynthia Ann Leump said  
Conveyance was made in consideration of Natural love and  
affection and the further consideration of one dollar paid which  
deed was on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of September 1848 duly recorded in  
the Clerk's office of the Edmondson County Court to which
